DT812: History of Christian Thought (HCT II) (3cr)

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course surveys the development of Catholic doctrine from the late ancient to the late medieval period, exploring the rich variety of historical schools, methods, and paradigms that formed the theological landscape of medieval Christendom. Theological developments in the doctrine of God, Christology, soteriology, spiritual theology, sacramental theology, and Christian anthropology will be discussed, with special emphasis on the progress made during this time in understanding the doctrines of the Most Holy Trinity, the human person, the dynamics of salvation, and their interconnections.
