DT863 Haritology/Grace (3cr)

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The understanding or ignorance of grace in the lives of Christians is of crucial importance for ministry and the life of the Church. The appreciation of this significant discipline of systematic theology accentuates the history of theology over the past seventy years. This course is open as an elective to MDiv, STB and STL students. It surveys the history of the development of Haritology (Grace) from its Scriptural evidence, via Augustine, Thomas Aquinas, the Council of Trent, Matthias Joseph Scheeben, Joseph Pohle, Charles Journet, Henri Rondet, Henri de Lubac, and Joseph Ratzinger, to Edward T. Oakes and the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*.
