

Code of Conduct

The Archdiocese of Chicago, under the leadership of Cardinal Blase Cupich, is committed to provide each seminarian with generous financial support which covers a substantial portion of the costs for his formation at Mundelein Seminary.

The seminarian, with the assistance of his family, where possible, is expected to support the remaining costs of priestly education with good stewardship to the best of his ability. Because the financial situation of each seminarian varies, no seminarian will be prevented from pursuing priestly formation at Mundelein Seminary because of a lack of funds. However, it is an expectation that, in justice, each seminarian will make every effort to see that his portion of the expenses of his formation will be satisfied.

The following Code of Conduct applies to any employee or agent of the Seminary who has responsibilities with respect to student educational loans:

1. Persons responsible for assisting students with educational loans shall not enter into any revenue-sharing arrangement with any lender.
2. Persons responsible for assisting students with educational loans shall not solicit or accept any gratuity, favor, discount, entertainment, hospitality, loan, or other item having a monetary value from a lender, guarantor, or servicer of education loans.
3. Persons responsible for assisting students with educational loans shall not accept from any lender or affiliate of any lender any fee, payment, or other financial benefit as compensation for any type of consulting arrangement or other contract to provide services to a lender or on behalf of a lender relating to education loans.
