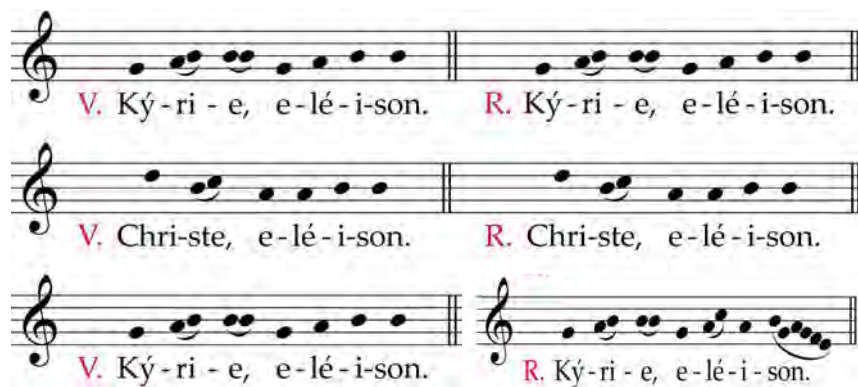

(Proclaimed in Spanish)
